



**FREE** weatherization upgrades to make your home more comfortable, safe and energy efficient.

## Program Overview

Project TEEM (Teaching **E**nergy **E**fficiency **M**asures) assists qualifying Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio (VEDO) customers in making energy efficiency improvements to their homes. The improvements are completed by your local Community Action Agency (CAP) at **NO COST** to qualifying customers. When complete, the upgrades will make your home more comfortable, safe and energy efficient.

## The Home Inspection

Qualifying customers will receive a home energy inspection by a qualified professional. As part of the inspection, the program will test your home's energy efficiency and offer solutions to reduce overall energy consumption. A safety test to verify that combustion appliances are operating safely will also be administered.



## Energy-Saving Measures

Depending on the results of the home energy assessment, the CAP representative may install one or more of the following energy efficiency measures:

- **Insulation**  
Add insulation to the attic, walls and crawl spaces helps to reduce energy use and increase comfort.
- **Sealing air leaks**  
Seal air leaks to reduce the cold drafts which may also improve indoor air quality.
- **Heating System Update**  
Replace an inefficient furnace or boiler to save energy and money.

## Eligibility

To qualify for Project TEEM, you must:

- Be a VEDO customer
- Meet income requirements (see enclosed chart)
