ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

The WCCS Energy Assistance Programs can help you and your family whether you are looking for financial assistance to cope with high energy bills, needing to make home repairs, or would like to make your home more efficient and safe.

Two programs are offered through WCCS: Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program (E-HEAP) and Weatherization.

Participants must meet household income eligibility guidelines.



EMERGENCY HEAP

The Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program (E-HEAP) assists low-income households with their energy needs. E-HEAP's two programs—the Winter Crisis Program and the Summer Crisis Program each have their own set of specific guidelines for assistance.

Winter Crisis Program

The Winter Crisis Program provides assistance to eligible households that are disconnected, threatened with disconnection of their primary or secondary heating source, or have less than a ten day supply of bulk fuel. Eligible clients may receive assistance once per heating season.

Summer Crisis Program

The Summer Crisis Program provides financial assistance to eligible seniors, age 60 or older, on their electric bill. Call in June to see when the Summer Crisis Program begins.



WEATHERIZATION

WCCS Weatherization assists income eligible Warren County residents reduce energy costs by improving the energy efficiency of their homes thus creating more affordable housing for those most in need. Income qualified homeowners and renters may receive this service if they meet the guidelines. WCCS has been serving the weatherization needs of Warren County since 1975.

Weatherization provides energy saving measures such as:

- Insulating attics, walls and basements
- Cleaning or repairing heating systems
- Performing safety testing and inspections
- Educating clients
- Sealing major air leaks around doors and windows
- Replacing broken window panes
- Wrapping hot water heaters, pipes etc.
- Making minor door repairs
- Filling holes around plumbing with foam
- Sealing return air/supply ducts coming into the home, if accessible
